# In 2023 We hosted a raffle in aid of Libby and Ex Meynell Pony Club member - Libby's Battle Against Small Cell Ovarian Cancer

Libby's Story

Our daughter, Libby, is 22 years old and she has been diagnosed with a very rare cancer, small cell ovarian cancer. There have only been 400 cases reported across the world.

On 22nd October 2023 Libby fell from her horse and was taken to hospital with a suspected fractured pelvis. Upon results of a CT scan it was identified that Libby had a very large mass in her abdomen. Libby was admitted to hospital and our lives were changed forever.

Initially we were told that Libby would under go surgery to remove the mass but the plan changed. We were told that surgery could not happen as the mass had attached itself to various organs and surgery would be too risky with a very high risk of loss of life.

The doctors appeared baffled as to what the mass was so a biopsy was taken on 27th October 2023. We waited patiently for two weeks then the results came back as inconclusive. The biopsy sample was then sent to a professor in Belfast to see if he could determine what the tumour was. In this time Libby's condition had deteriorated significantly and we were told that there was a possibility that Libby's heart may stop working over the of weekend 18/19 of November 2023. Libby proved them wrong and continues to fight to beat this cancer.

On the evening of 17th November 2023 the diagnosis was received, small cell ovarian cancer.

Libby will undergo chemotherapy, followed by surgery, followed by radiotherapy and then finally immunotherapy. It is immunotherapy that we are seeking help for. This cancer is a nasty cancer and likes to come back. This therapy will give Libby the best chance to fight off any further cancer that might come back in the future. It is not currently funded via the NHS and costs around £8,000 per treatment and would be required every 3 weeks. In total this will cost in excess of £250,000. We are doing all we can to raise as much funds as we possibly can ourselves and would very much appreciate any help you can offer.

Classes run as single phase (except the Pairs Class, see below). i.e. first phase will not be timed and riders proceed straight to the second phase, which will be timed. All riders will go through to timed phase unless eliminated.

# Class 4. Merry Mini PAIRS - 55cms

Class 6. PAIRS Reindeer Dash – 80cm Sponsored by JAL Solar

The pair's competition will be judged on the fastest time with 5 seconds added for each knockdown or fence refusal. The 1<sup>st</sup> combination to jump must hand over a whip to the 2nd combination having completed the 1st round. The 2<sup>nd</sup> combination then jumps the 2nd round. The time is started when the 1st pony passes through the start and stops when the 2nd pony passes through the finish. If either of the pair is eliminated (three refusals) the other combination may take the whip and complete the course from the point of elimination.

But be safe to jump (see conditions of entry)\*

No pony may enter more than 3 classes

- Meynell Pony Club Entry fees are £14.50 per class (£12 clear round, £25 for the pairs round for 2 riders)
- Entries from other Pony Clubs are most welcome. Entry fees are £16 per class (£14 clear round, £27 for the pairs round for 2 riders)

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The event will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping rules 2024.

- Hats must conform to Pony Club standards and be tagged.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Open to MEMBERS of any Pony Club Branch. Entries will be received on a first come, first served basis.
- Objections in writing with a deposit of £25 accepted according to Pony Club rules within 15 minutes of the incident occurring.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes with a small entry or refuse any entry.
- No Refunds after 11<sup>th</sup> Dec 2024 for whatever reason. No Substitutions after the closing date. Before 11<sup>th</sup> Dec 24 full refunds to be given.
- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the organisers
- All horses/ponies entering the event site must comply with 2024 Pony Club vaccination rules.
- Horses and ponies must be 5 years old or over. No Stallions are permitted without Meynell DC approval.

- Please ensure that you pick up any droppings or litter from around the lorry/trailer park before leaving.
- ENTRY FEE: Entrymaster £1.20 non-refundable booking fee per entry. In the event of the abandonment of the event, £7 per class entry will be retained by the organising branch to contribute to administration and cancellation costs.
- No horse or pony is to be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/horsebox.
- Fancy Dress Limited, securely fastened Xmas decorations will be allowed on horse/riders. To be
  checked by stewards. However no 'full fancy dress' costumes please to ensure jumping can be done
  safely.

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers, all officials and stewards.
