Entries Close: 11th March 2024 or earlier if fully booked.

PLEASE NOTE – We recommend booking in advance to guarantee your place as this is a popular event and is part of the CHEVAL LIBERTE AREA 6 Show Jumping League.

- Class 1. **Easter Bunny Hop CLEAR ROUND** – CROSS POLES (Low as we can go with cross pole)
- Class 2: Teddy Bear Hop **CLEAR ROUND** (New Class) – (Low as we can go with straight pole)
- Class 3. 40cm - Easter Chick Challenge (Genuine Novices).
- Class 4. 50cms - Mini Eggstravaganza
- Class 5. 60cms Individual – Easter Bunny Bounce
- Class 6. 60cms PAIRS – **Chicken & Egg Scramble Pairs**
- Class 7. 70cms – Easter Bonnet Bonanza
- Class 8. 80cm Individual - Crème Egg Stakes
- Class 9. 80cm PAIRS – **Hot & Cross Bunny Relay Pairs**
- Class 10. 90cms - Daffodil Derby
- Class 11. 1m - Spring Lamb Leap

Classes run as single phase (except the Pairs Class, see below). i.e. first phase will not be timed and riders proceed straight to the second phase, which will be timed. All riders will go through to timed phase unless eliminated.

Class 6. **60cms PAIRS** – Chicken & Egg Scramble Pairs

Class 9. **80cm PAIRS** – Hot & Cross Bunny Relay Pairs

The pair's competition will be judged on the fastest time with 5 seconds added for each knockdown or fence refusal. The 1st combination to jump must hand over a whip to the 2nd combination having completed the 1st round. The 2nd combination then jumps the 2nd round. The time is started when the 1st pony passes through the start and stops when the 2nd pony passes through the finish. If either of the pair is eliminated (three refusals) the other combination may take the whip and complete the course from the point of elimination.

No pony may enter more than 3 classes

- Meynell Pony Club Entry fees are **£14.50** per class (**£12** clear round, **£25** for the pairs round for 2 riders)
- Entries from other Pony Clubs are most welcome. Entry fees are **£16** per class (**£14** clear round, **£27** for the pairs round for 2 riders)

Individual rosettes to 6th place *Sponsored by Cheval Liberté*

Prizes in kind to 3rd place.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The event will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping rules 2024.

- Hats must conform to Pony Club standards and be tagged.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Open to MEMBERS of any Pony Club Branch. Entries will be received on a first come, first served basis.
- Objections in writing with a deposit of £25 accepted according to Pony Club rules within 15 minutes of the incident occurring.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes with a small entry or refuse any entry.
- No Refunds after 11th March 2024 for whatever reason. No Substitutions after the closing date. Before 11th March 2024 full refunds to be given.
- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the organisers
- All horses/ponies entering the event site must comply with 2024 Pony Club vaccination rules.
- Horses and ponies must be 5 years old or over. No Stallions are permitted without Meynell DC approval.

- Please ensure that you pick up any droppings or litter from around the lorry/trailer park before leaving.
- ENTRY FEE: Entrymaster - £1.20 non-refundable booking fee per entry. In the event of the abandonment of the event, 50% of the class entry will be retained by the organising branch to contribute to administration and cancellation costs.
- No horse or pony is to be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/horsebox.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers, all officials and stewards.
